The Center provides non-shelter assistance to individuals and families in the community who are at-risk of becoming homeless. Non-shelter services include food, clothing, personal hygiene items, furniture, etc. Since these items are donated to CARES, they are distributed at no cost to the recipients. Limited travel assistance is available for stranded travelers.
