Avalon advocates provide counseling and education for victims of domestic violence, stalking, and sexual assault who are not staying at a shelter. Advocates are available to provide support through police departments, hospitals, social service agencies and more, making follow-up calls to any victim in a domestic violence case who allows her name to be released. Victims receive crisis intervention and compassionate emotional support during this traumatic time. Avalon's advocacy

program coordinates with the criminal justice system and other services and seeks to inform victims of their rights which enables them to make an informed choice.

Educating the community about domestic violence, stalking, and sexual assault is a key component of Avalon's mission. Through our education and training programs, we hope to build a society that understands the impact of relationship violence on adults, children and the community and how we can break the cycle of abuse once and for all.
