WWRC offers a highly experienced and dedicated staff, up-to-date equipment, and an encouraging environment on a fully accessible campus. Spinal cord injury services are provided by an interdisciplinary team of experienced clinicians, including a physiatrist; nurses; personal care assistants; physical, occupational, and speech therapists; psychologists; vocational evaluators; vocational educators; and case managers.

WWRC also offers a Spinal Cord Injury Follow-up Clinic on a monthly basis. Recommendations for follow-up evaluations through this clinic may be made as clients complete their medical rehabilitation programs
