The Commonwealth's system of services and supports for individuals with developmental disabilities has undergone significant transformation as Virginia redesigned its waiver system under the My Life, My Community (MLMC) initiative. The term My Life, My Community encompasses an overarching vision whereby people with developmental disabilities live, work, play and thrive in their communities, just as others do, with the support they need.
