Supportive services include case management, life skills support, job readiness program, and more.

Supportive services for residential clients include:

- Case Management
- Life Skills Support
- Job Readiness Program
- Assistance with application for mainstream services such as disability benefits & food stamps
- Referral and placement coordination to Recovery Programs
- Transportation to job interviews/doctor visits
